

GCSE Spanish

Overview

GCSE Spanish builds on the knowledge gained during Key Stage 3, and furnishes learners with the ability to communicate and understand the Spanish language in a variety of contexts, and for a range of purposes.

What will I study?

The areas studied fall under the three broad themes of learning language for: leisure and wellbeing, travel, and study and work.

Within these learners will acquire the vocabulary and syntax to read, speak and write about topics such as technology and social media, travel, the environment, career plans, and local and regional features of France.

Assessment

There are three examined units, covering the key skill areas of speaking, listening, reading and writing, along with a non-examined assessment focused on writing.

Units	Content	Weight
Unit 1: Oracy	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Non-examined assessment.• Three tasks: read aloud and role play, presentation and discussion, conversation.	30%
Unit 2: Reading and Writing	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Non-examined assesment.• Written response to set task, based around a Spanish graphic novel, short story, film scxript or novel.	15%
Unit 3: Listening	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 1 hour written examination.• Listening comprehension tasks, with fixed and written responses	20%
Unit 4: Reading and Writing	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 1 hour 30 min written examination.• Reading comprehension tasks, translation from Spanish to English, and a writing task in response to simple and familiar stimuli.	35%
