

## Science Triple (optional)

Learners wishing to gain separate GCSEs in each Science (Biology, Chemistry and Physics) are able to choose 'Triple Science'. They will have timetabled core science lessons with the rest of the year, and additional hours to complete the qualification will take place in one of the option columns.

Triple Science is NOT compulsory, learners will have to actively opt to study it, in place of a third options subject.
